## 2025-2026 Verification Worksheet Dependent

Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the US Department of Education for a review process called verification. The law states that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm information that you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Office will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents and submit everything to the Financial Aid Office. We reserve the right to ask you for additional information. If you have any questions about verification, contact the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

### B. Family Household Information

In addition to the Belmont College Student, include:

- **Parents' other children**, even if they don't live with the parents, if the parents will provide more than half of the child's support from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026, or if the children would be required to provide parental information when completing a FAFSA for 2025-2026.
- **Other people** if they now live with the parents and the parents provide more than half of the other person's support and will continue to provide more than half of that person's support through June 30, 2026.
